### Frequently Asked Questions

**1. What academic programs and/or classes are offered at APSU @ the Renaissance Center?**

APSU will offer courses leading to a Bachelor of Business Administration with a concentration in management. Class schedules and other information is found at [www.apsu.edu/dickson](http://www.apsu.edu/dickson).

**2. Will all courses for the whole BBA degree be available at APSU @ the Renaissance Center?**

Yes, all courses needed for the BBA with a concentration in management will be offered at the Renaissance Center. Course delivery may vary between face-to-face, ITV and online. An academic advisor will assist you in choosing classes according to your degree plan.

**3. How do I apply for Admission?**

**4. What is the COMPASS assessment?**

COMPASS is an untimed, computerized assessment that measures skills in reading, writing, and mathematics. It provides important information about individual skills and preparation for college-level courses.

**5. What is APSU's OneStop?**

APSU's OneStop is your personalized OneStop portal which includes information about your APSU APMail e-mail address which APSU will use in communicating with you, class registration, financial aid, housing, admissions, and more. To log in, you will need your APSU Student Identification Number and PIN, which will be included with your acceptance letter. To login to OneStop, please visit <http://onestop.apsu.edu>.

**6. How do I register for classes?**

All APSU students register for classes online after discussing their academic options with an academic advisor. You will receive information on academic advising after you are admitted to APSU. Upon meeting with your academic advisor, you will be given an Alternate PIN which will allow you to register via OneStop at <http://onestop.apsu.edu>. **7. How much will I have to pay?**

Costs vary depending on many factors, including but not limited to the number of courses registered for, your residency classification, and changes to tuition and fees. APSU students who take classes at the Renaissance Center are charged according to the APSU Main Campus tuition and fees schedule, which is available [http://apsu.edu/businessoffice/acctrec/tuition\\_fees.htm](http://apsu.edu/businessoffice/acctrec/tuition_fees.htm).

**8. How will I be billed?**

If you pre-register for classes, your bill is sent to you electronically via your APSU e-mail address approximately 6 to 8 weeks prior to the first day of classes. If you do not pre-register for classes, your bill may be accessed via OneStop. Both your OneStop account and your email can be accessed at <http://onestop.apsu.edu>.

**9. May I receive financial aid?**

Financial assistance is available to students who are enrolled at least half time at either APSU or NSCC or both institutions. To be eligible for financial aid, students must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). Students interested in studying at Dickson are encouraged to include the APSU Financial Aid Code (003478) and the NSCC Financial Aid Code (008145) on their FAFSA.

**10. Can I be an APSU and NSCC student at the same time?**

You will be a student at both APSU and NSCC if you choose to enroll in classes from both institutions during the same semester. Both APSU and NSCC will offer courses at the Renaissance Center in Dickson beginning in the Fall 2009. Students may choose to take classes from one or both institutions at any given time.

**11. Will I have access to university services if I am an APSU student at the Renaissance Center?**

Yes, if you have registered and paid tuition and fees for one or more APSU classes, you will have access, electronically and on campus, to all library facilities, as well as on campus access to the fitness center, athletic events, and a student identification card.

**12. What if have a learning or physical disability?**
