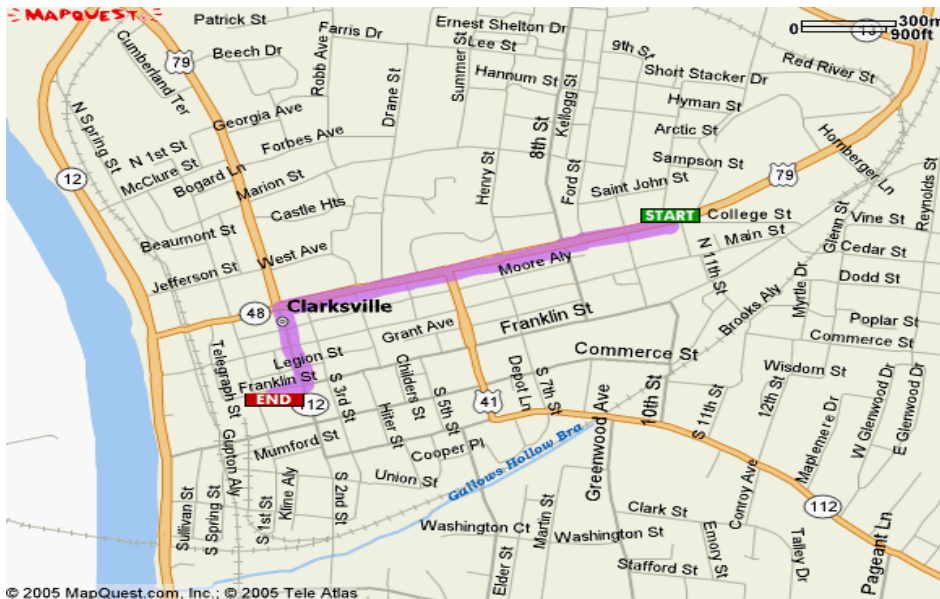
Directions from APSU:
