We have a formal process that must be met before an animal is approved. The steps are listed below.

- A qualified, professional provider such as an M.D. must provide documentation on original letterhead with an original signature. The letter must state all of the following:
 - a. The diagnosis and functional limitations as to why an animal is needed.
 - b. The job or service the animal provides must be listed and how it accommodates the disability.
 - c. The type of animal (dog or cat) must be listed on the documentation letter.
- 2. All of the above is required to be in place and an intake interview completed with SDRC prior to bringing the animal to campus.
- 3. The student application for services with our office should be completed along with your documentation at the following link: https://teton.accessiblelearning.com/APSU/ApplicationStudent.aspx
- 4. Housing will schedule a meeting with you to discuss the handling and health of the animal as well as your responsibilities.
 - a. There is an additional form for housing that will be signed off on by our office.
