As in previous years, the contest will be held at the gym in the Memorial Health Building (also known as The Red Barn) on the Austin Peay campus.

The cost of purchasing extra test copies this year will be \$2, while supplies last. As in the past, there are six divisions: Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Statistics, Precalculus, and Calculus/advanced topics.



PARKING

<u>Buses</u>

From College Street, turn onto Drane Street and continue until you see the Memorial Health Building on your right. Buses may unload at the steps in front of the Memorial Health Building. CALCULATORS

Calculators are allowed in all divisions in the contest. Any calculator capable of symbolic manipulation is prohibited. Any calculator allowed on the ACT Math exam is acceptable. Refer to the ACT calculator rules for more details on specific models.

Note: Each year a few contestants will have calculators with dead batteries. Please bring extra calculators or batteries in case that happens. We do not have extras to loan to students.

CALCULATORS ARE ALLOWED ON ALL SIX TESTS. ANY CALCULATOR CAPABLE OF SYMBOLIC MANIPULATION IS NOT ALLOWED. STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO USE CELL PHONES OR TEXT DEVICES DURING THE TESTS. ANY CALCULATOR ALLOWED ON THE ACT MATH EXAM IS ACCEPTABLE. REFER TO THE ACT CALCULATOR RULES FOR MORE DETAIL ON SPECIFIC MODELS.

Please also note the following points.

*Calculators and/or batteries will not be provided by the test center.

*Students will not be allowed to swap or share calculators.

*Test administrators have no responsibility for checking and/or clearing a calculators' memory.

*All questions on the algebra I, algebra II, and geometry tests will be calculator neutral. This means that the use of a graphing calculator will not give a student an unfair advantage over a student who does not use a calculator.

*Some questions on the statistics, precalculus, and calculus/advanced topics tests will be calculator neutral. Other questions will probably be best answered with the aid of a graphing calculator, but these questions will not be identified on the test forms.
