ACADEMIC MISCONDUCT — DEFINITION

What is Academic Misconduct?

- According to APSU's Student Handbook:
- Plagiarism
- Cheating or unauthorized aid
- · Falsification of documents
- Collusion
- Applies to both direct and indirect involvement



- Faculty maintain control over classroom behavior

- Extended exclusion requires Student Affairs involvement

- Failing assignment/course

- Academic penalties may include:

- Reprimand, probation, suspension,

Misconduct Reported by Faculty

Case Reviewed by Community Care & Standards

Student Conduct Meeting or Hearing


Outcome Letter Issued

Sanctions Assigned (if responsible)

Student Completes Sanctions

Appeals allowed for suspension/expulsion only





BEST PRACTICES FOR FACULTY



Grade was lowered due to misconduct

Appeals follow Academic Grievance Procedures

They feel they were erroneously accused

Retailiation

WHAT IF A STUDENT DISAGREES?



UNDERSTANDING STUDENT ABSENCE NOTIFICATIONS

Faculty set attendance policies in their syllabi

Students must contact faculty about absences

In emergencies (e.g., death, hospitalization):

Central Student Affairs can notify faculty

Faculty still set make-up work terms



When you receive an absence notification: • It signals a concern, not an excuse

Student still responsible for follow-up

- Opportunity to offer academic support
- Collaborate with Care Team as needed
