# Adjunct Spotlight



Gerald Beavers is currently an adjunct professor for the Department of Criminal Justice. His career with Austin Peay began in July 1996 when he came on board as the Program Manager for Criminal Justice, bringing with him 32 years of active policing experience.

Over the years, Mr. Beavers was promoted to Assistant Professor and Director of the School of Technology and Public

Management (1999), Executive Director of the AP Center at Fort Campbell (2001), and then Professor Emeritus in Criminal Justice upon his retirement in 2007. He has been adjunct teaching and advising ever since.

Mr. Beavers is a highly respected instructor, by both his students and his co-workers. He loves to incorporate a good story into his teachings and is enthusiastic about passing along all of his experience and knowledge to his students. Currently, Mr. Beavers is responsible for the dual enrollment offerings for students from several surrounding area high schools.
