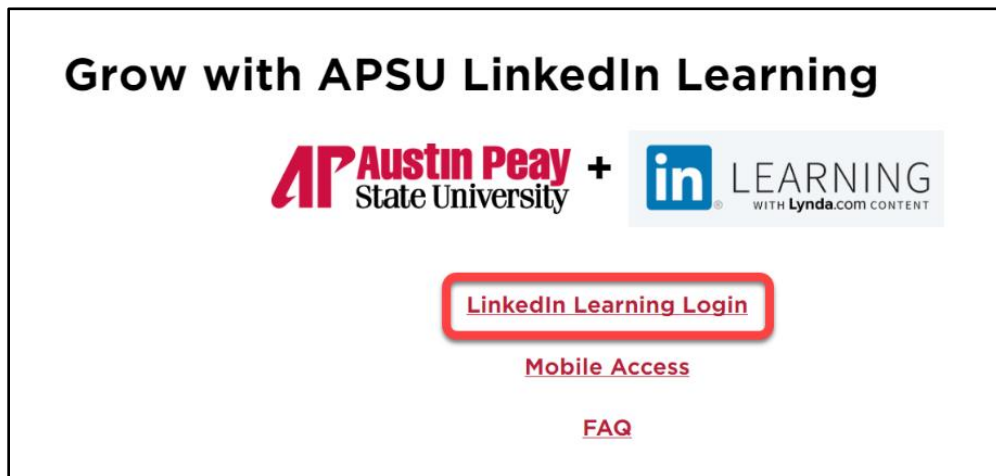


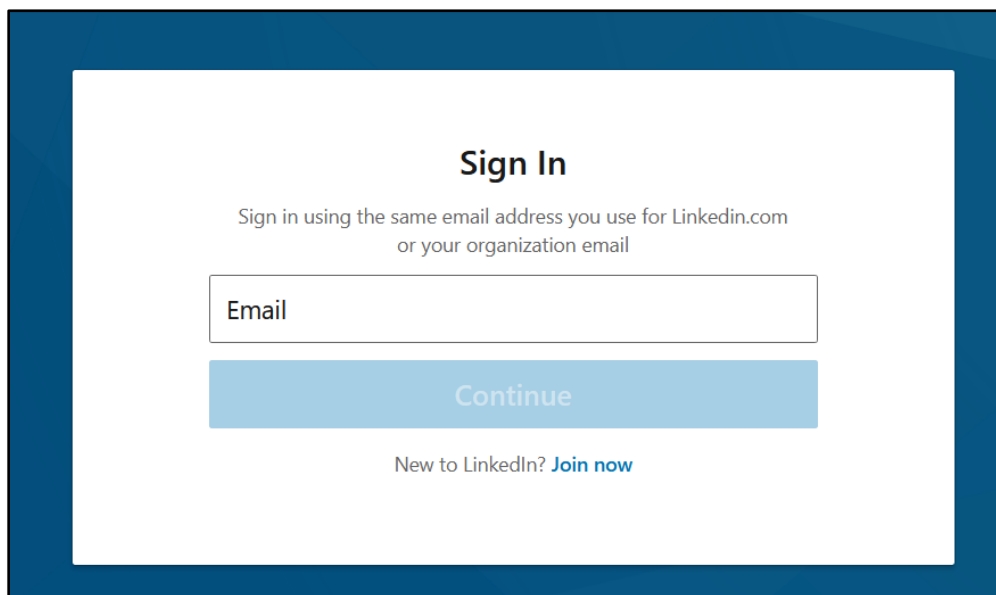
Log in to LinkedIn Learning

If you have not already activated your free APSU account, please refer to this [guide on activating your LinkedIn Learning account](#). If you have already activated your account, proceed with the steps below.


1. Go to [APSU's LinkedIn Learning website](#).
2. Select "LinkedIn Learning Login."



3. Enter your APSU email in the address box and select "Continue."




4. If you previously linked your LinkedIn Learning and LinkedIn profile accounts, you will be asked to provide your LinkedIn profile password. **Note:** this screen is asking for your LinkedIn profile login information for LinkedIn.com. It is NOT your APSU single sign-on information. For example, this could be your Gmail or Yahoo email used to set up your LinkedIn account.



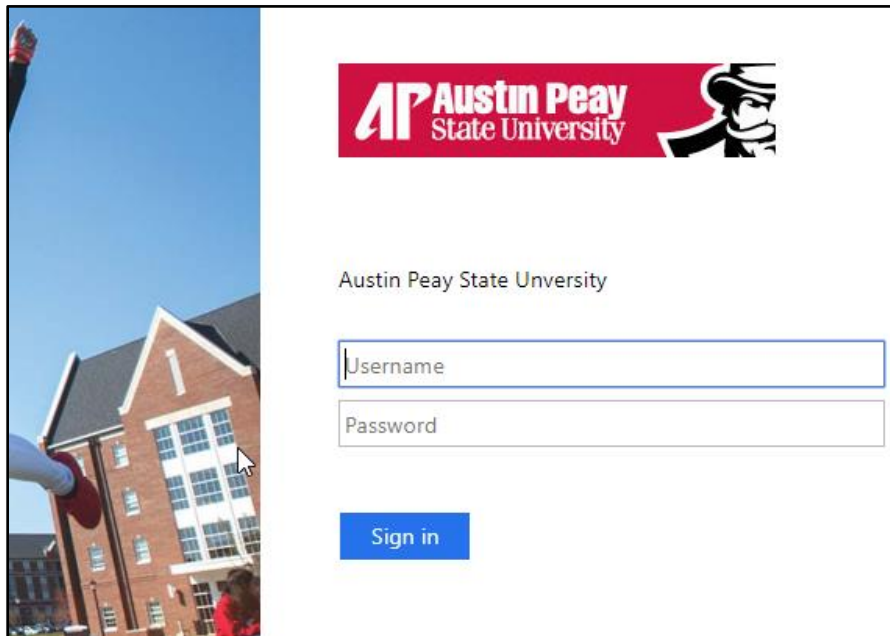
