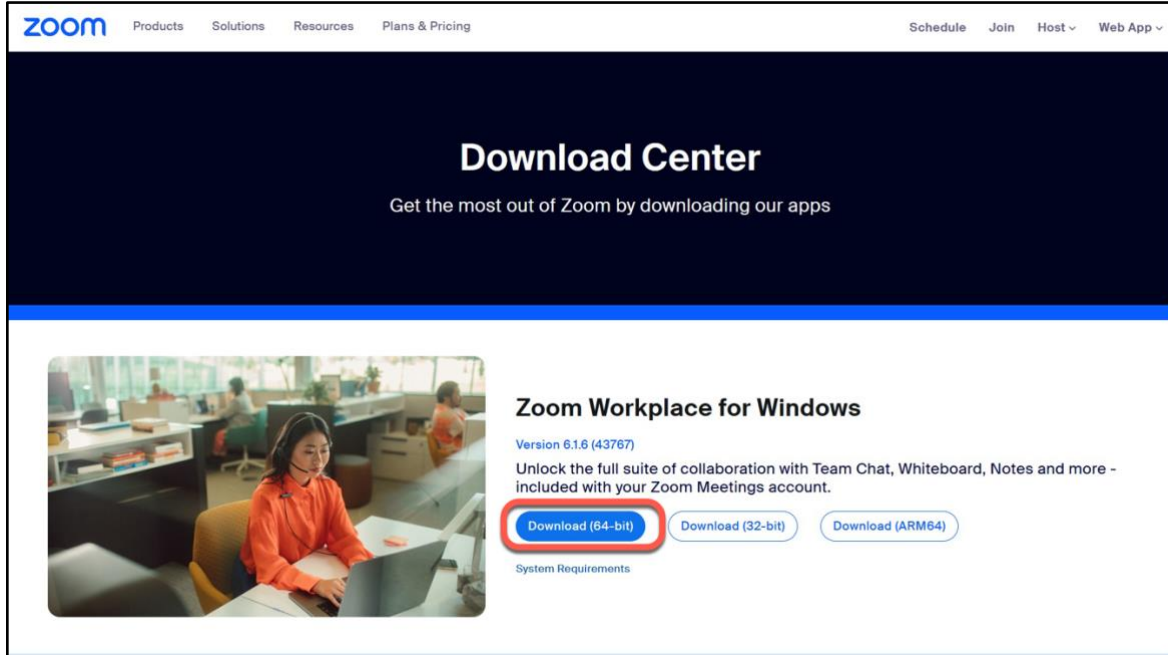

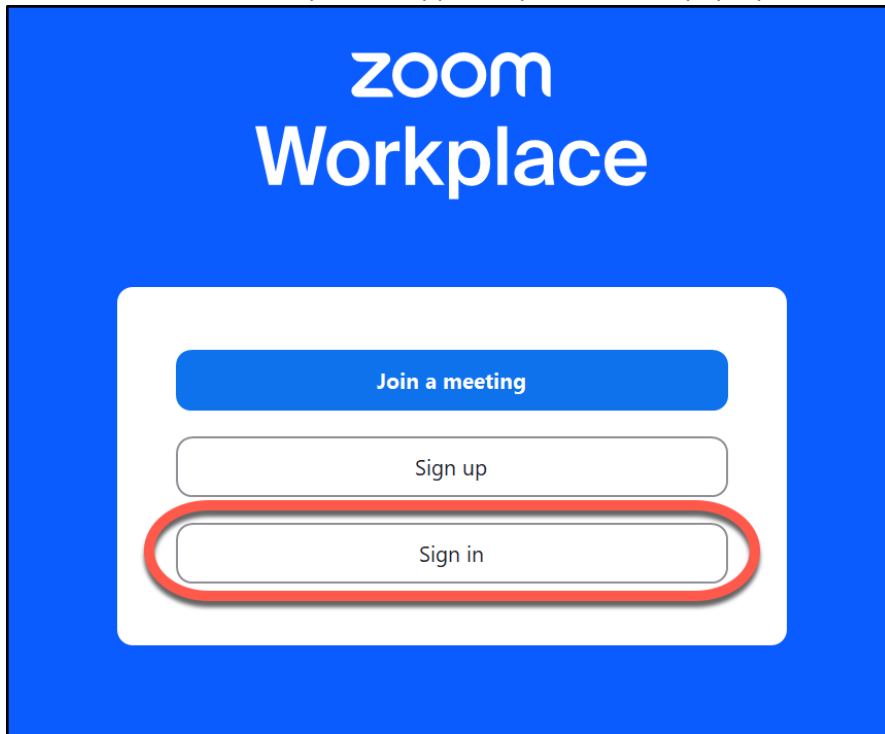
Downloading the Zoom Workplace App

Follow these steps to download the Zoom app on your device. Note: an APSU-issued device may need to have Zoom installed by OIT. If this is the case, please get in touch with GOVSTECH for assistance with the installation.

1. Navigate to Zoom’s Download Center and select the “Zoom Workplace App” download option.




2. Once Zoom downloads, open the app, and you will see a pop-up window to sign in. Select “Sign In”.





3. Then, select “Sign in with SSO.”

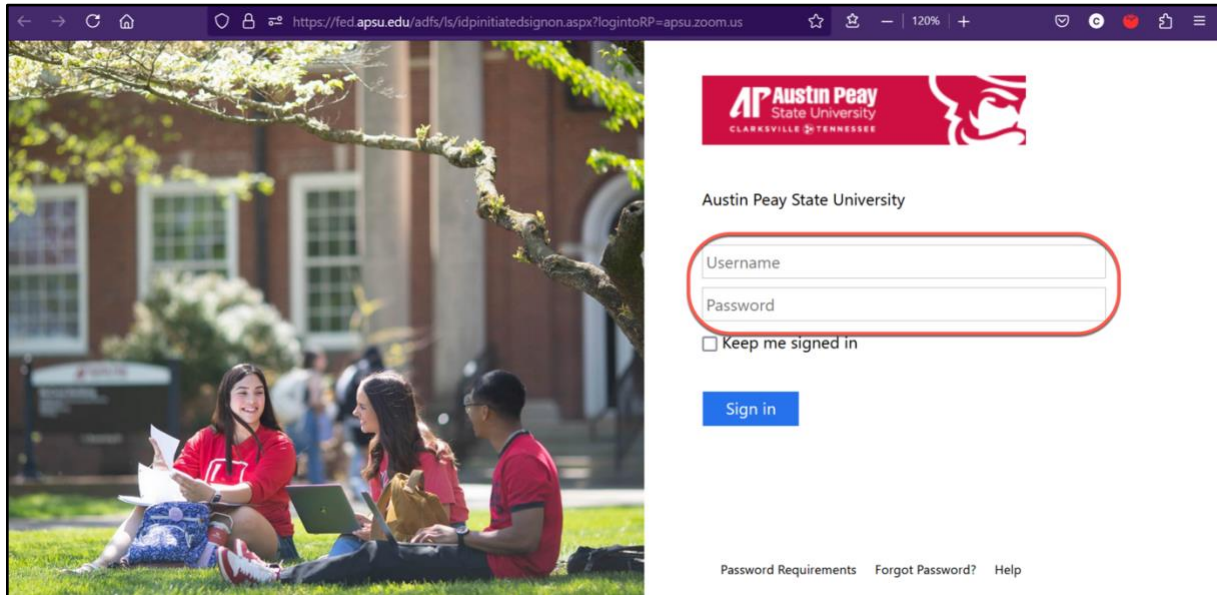
4. Enter “APSU” in the “Company Domain” field and select “Continue”.
