• THEC meeting: Tennessee Higher Education Commission meeting held no surprises. Approve preliminary budget increase of 0-4%. Final

decision will be make in February.

- Governor's budget meeting: Scheduled for end of January beginning of February. No updates.
- Provost Search: First-round interviews will take place in December. Goal is to hopefully have the search wrapped by spring break in March, and the new Provost will take over July 1.
- FLSA: federal court in Texas vacated the entirety of the new FLSA rule.
   Department of Labor can appeal, so APSU will wait to see when/ if they do. They will make a decision about whether or not to continue on with changes as announced or not based on updates as they come out.
