Books

In-text Citation Format

(Author Last name (s), Year of Publication, Page Range)

Examples

(Cowan 2015:75)

(Smith 2010:25)

Reference Page Format

Last Name, First Name. Year of Publication. "Title of Essays in Book Chapter." pp. page range. *Book Title*. Location: Publisher.

Examples

Cowan, Sarah. 2015. "Gender Dynamics in Modern Society." In *Contemporary Perspectives on Gender: Essays on Equality and Identity*, edited by Emily Adams, 65-80. Chicago: XYZ Press.

Smith, John. 2010. "Effects of Globalization." In *Understanding Globalization: Essays on Economics and Society*, edited by Mary Johnson, 20-35. New York: ABC Publishing.

Book with Two or More Authors

In-text Citation Format

(Author1's Last Name and Author2's Last Name Year)

Examples

(Black and White 2020)

(Smith and Johnson 2018)

Reference Page Format

Author1's Last Name, First Name, and Author2's First Name Last Name. Year of Publication. Title of the Book. Publisher.

Examples

Black, James, and Sarah White. 2020. *Exploring Diversity: Essays on Race and Identity*. HarperCollins.

Smith, John, and Emily Johnson. 2018. *Sociological Perspectives: An Introduction*. Oxford University Press.

Chapter in an Edited Volume

In-text Citation Format

(Author Last name(s) Year of Publication, Page Range)

Examples

(Brown and Getz 2011)

(Johnson and Lee 2019)

Reference Page Format

Author Last Name, First Name. Year of Publication. "Title of Essay or Chapter." Pp. page range. In *Book Title*, edited by Editor's First Name Last Name. Location: Publisher.

Examples

Brown, Sandy, and Christy Getz. 2011. "Farmworker Food Insecurity and the Production of Hunger in California." Pp. 121-146. In *Cultivating Food Justice: Race, Class, and Sustainability*, edited by A.H. Alkon and J. Agyeman. Cambridge, MA: MIT Press.

Johnson, Michael, and Karen Lee. 2019. "Urbanization and Environmental Sustainability: Challenges and Opportunities." Pp. 55-72. In *Cities and the Environment: Exploring Urban Sustainability*, edited by David Smith and Sarah Brown. New York: Routledge.

Book with No Author



Title of the Book. Year of Publication. Publisher.

Examples

Global Economic Trends. 2024. Oxford University Press.

Introduction to Sociology. 2022. McGraw-Hill Education.
