CSE Style (In-Text Citations)

In-Text Citations

• You must include the last name of the author(s) and the year of publication in the text of your paper.

• Include last name and year in parentheses:

• **Example:** Fluoridated water as well as various fluoride products such as toothpaste provide fluoride ions necessary for remineralization (Jones 2020).

• Include the last name in the text and the year in parentheses:

• **Example:** Jones states that fluoridated water as well as various fluoride products such as toothpaste provide fluoride ions necessary for remineralization (2020).

• 2 authors:

• **Example:** (Jones and Adams 2020)

• More than 2 authors:

• Example: (Jones et al. 2020)

• No author:

• **Example:** (Fluoridated water... 2020) - use the first few letters of the title and follow with an ellipsi

• No date:

• **Example:** (Smith [Date unknown]) - use the first few letters of the title and follow with an ellipsi

CSE Style (Reference List)

Book - Single Author:

- Author Last Name First Initial(s). Date of publication. Title of book. Publisher location:
 Publisher.
- **Example:** Hamilton LD. 2018. The Arctic fox: life at the top of the world. New York: Voyageur Press.

Book - 2 authors:

• Example: Wagner M, Taylor AW. 2019. The life of Mark Twain. San Francisco: History Press.

Book - 3+ authors (list all authors):

• Example: Smith TM, Jones AM, Thompson PN, Pernell WT, Nixon LJ, Wilson MT. 2020. Landmarks of scientific socialism. Cambridge: Cambridge University Press.

E-Book:

• Example: Wagner M, Taylor AW. 2019. The life of Mark Twain [Internet]. San Francisco: History Press; [cited 2020 Sept 28]. Available from: https://ebookcentral.proquest.com/lib/surricc-ebooks/detail.action?docID=1188357

Edited Book:

- Editor Last Name First Initial(s). Date of publication. Title of book. Publisher location: Publisher.
- Example: Munoz LP, Young AS, editors. 2020. The German ideology. New York: Penguin.

Article from a Library Database:

- Author last name, first initial(s). Date. Article Title. Abbreviated journal title [Internet]. [cited date]; volume(issue): page numbers. Available from: web address (include the DOI number, article or document number, if available)
- Example: Castonguay LG, Boswell JF, Constantino MJ, Goldfried MR, Hill CE. 2010 Jan. Training implications of harmful effects of psychological treatments. Am Psychol [Internet]. [accessed 2019 Oct 24]; 65(1):34-49. Available from: https://login.proxy172.nclive.org/login?url=https://www.proquest.com/docview/1858170730?accountid=14179

Web page:
