### Chicago Style 17th Edition - Citing Journal Articles

#### Chicago Style 17th Edition - Journal Articles

- In notes, cite specific page numbers; in the bibliography, include the entire article's page range. For online articles, include a URL or database name. Preferably, use the DOI (Digital Object Identifier) as a permanent URL, starting with <https://doi.org/>, rather than the browser's URL.
- For journal articles with numerous authors, list up to ten in the bibliography. In notes, list only the first author followed by "et al." For over ten authors, include the first seven followed by "et al."

#### Basic Format

Author(s). "Article Title." *Journal Title* volume, no. issue (Year): page range. DOI or URL (if accessed online).
