# **MLA Style 9th Edition - Citing Websites**

#### **Basic Format**

Author's Last Name, First Name. *Title of Website*, Name of Organization Affiliated with the Website, Date of copyright or date last modified/updated, URL. Accessed access date (optional).

## **Example**

Mabillard, Amanda. *Shakespeare Online*, 29 Dec. 2011, www.shakespeare-online.com. Accessed 6 July 2016.

## Specific Page or Document on Website

## **In-text Citation Format**

(Author's Last Name).

## **Examples**

(Poncelet).

(Smith).

#### **Works Cited Format**

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Title of Page or Document." *Title of Website*, Name of Organization Affiliated with the Website, Date of copyright or date last modified/updated, URL.

## **In-text Citation Format**

("Title of Page or Document").

"Title of Page or Document." *Title of Website*, Name of Organization Affiliated with the Website, Date of copyright or date last modified/updated, URL.

# Website Created by a Corporation, Institution, or Group

#### **In-text Citation Format**

(Corporation, Institution, or Group Name).

## **Examples**

(Chartered Professional Accountants Canada).

(World Health Organization).

#### **Works Cited Format**

Name of Corporation/Group/Organization. "Title of Section." *Title of Website*, Publisher or Sponsoring Organization, Date of publication or last modified date, URL. Accessed access date.

(Author's Last Name).

#### **Works Cited Format**

Author's Last Name, First Name. *Title of Book*. Publisher, Year of Publication. Title of Website, Name of Website Publisher, URL.

Doe, John. *Introduction to Psychology*. Pearson, 2018. OpenStax, Rice University, openstax.org/details/books/introduction-psychology.

Smith, Sarah. *The Art of Cooking*. Penguin Books, 2015. Project Gutenberg, www.gutenberg.org/ebooks/12345.

## Journal Article in a Database

# **In-text Citation Format**

(Author's Last Name)

# **Examples**

(Garcia).

(Chen and Patel).

#### **Works Cited Format**

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." *Title of Journal*, vol. X, no. X, Year, pages. Name of Database, DOI or URL.

# **Examples**

Chen, Wei, and Patel, Ravi. "Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare." *Journal of Medical Research*, vol. 10, no. 2, 2019, pp. 112-125. ProQuest, doi:10.1234/jmr.2019.0001.

Garcia, Maria. "Effects of Climate Change on Biodiversity." *Environmental Science Journal*, vol. 25, no. 3, 2020, pp. 45-58. JSTOR, www.jstor.org/stable/123456789.
