

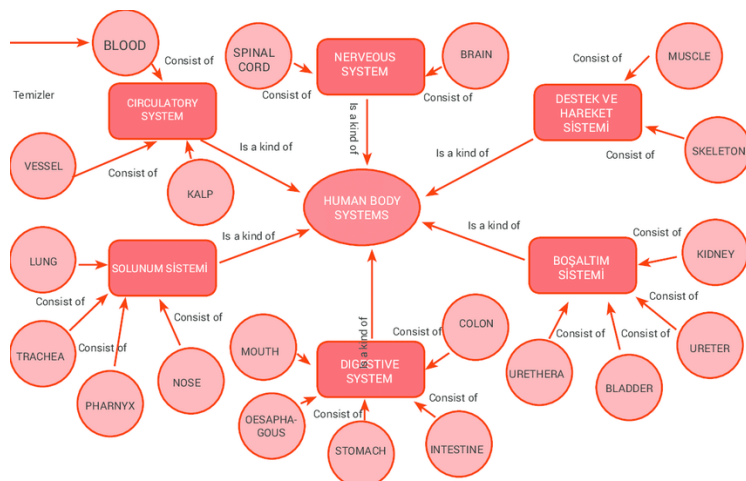
### Mapping Note-Taking Method

- Connects different thoughts, ideas, concepts, and facts through visualization.
- Starts with a central topic and branches into smaller subtopics.
- Gives a comprehensive overview of a large subject.
- Focuses on connecting ideas over chronology.

### How to use:

1. Write the main idea in a center box/circle/bubble.
2. Write each subtopic in circles linked to the outside of the main box/circle/bubble.
3. Draw pictures and interlink items

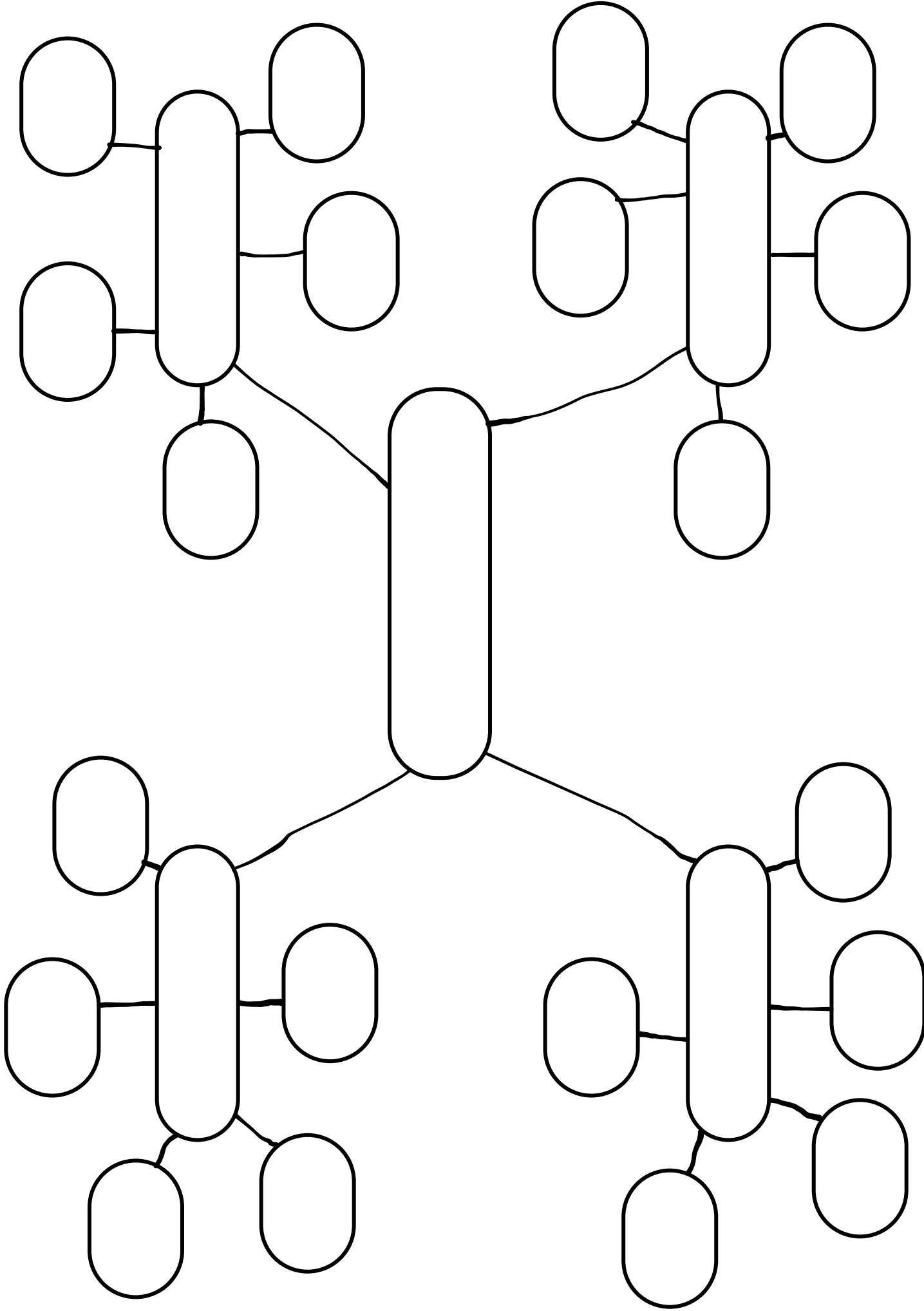
