What are transitional sentences?

- Transitional sentences are phrases or clauses that connect ideas and help guide the reader through your writing.
- We use transitional sentences to...
 - Show how one idea relates to another.
 - Help the audience understand the order of events.
 - Provide support and clarification to our ideas.
 - Reinforce the main idea before moving onto a new topic.
 - Explain how ideas are related.
