Sentence Note-Taking Method

Sentence Note-Taking Method

- Best for fast-paced, in-class lectures, or unstructured lessons.
- Uses sentences separated by lines to quickly transcribe as much information as possible from the information source.
- Distinguish between different, unrelated topics by creating a line break.
- Consider combining the sentence method with another note-taking method when rewriting your notes.
- Simply writing down what your instructor is saying in the form of sentences.


How to use:

- 1. Write down each sentence on a separate line.
- 2. Number your lines.
- 3. Review your notes.

Sentence Note-Taking Examples:

Sleep Disorders

- Sleep terrors occur at stage 4 of NREM
- Nightmares have no consistent duration
- Sleepwalkers cannot recall their sleepwalking
- There is no known cure for nightmares
- A common cause of sleepwalking is fatigue
- Sleepwalkers are easily awakened
- Sleepwalking occurs during NREM sleep
- · Sleep terrors: no recollection of content
- Sleept terrors occur within 15-90 min of sleep
- Sleep terrors last up to 20 min per episode
- There are 80+ types of sleep disorders
- Most common sleep disorder is insomnia
- Sleep apnea is another common sleep disorder
